The office is open to all military personnel, family members, retirees, civilians, and contractors.

### MILITARY VOTING

The Federal Voting Assistance Program is for all military voters, spouses and dependents, and overseas civilians. All can use the SF 76 (Federal Postcard Application) to register to vote in their home state, to request a ballot, or to update personal information, including mailing address. If you are stationed in your state of legal residence, or wish to establish residency in the state in which you are stationed, you can register and vote locally. Contact your IVAO for assistance and information.

### DEPLOYING PERSONNEL

Meet with voting assistance office staff before deploying for 30 days or more. You can obtain an FPCA or Federal Absentee Write-In Ballot to bring with you to ensure you have an opportunity to request a ballot from your state of legal residence or to complete a write-in ballot if your state/county ballot does not arrive in time. Be sure to visit when you return home to update your mailing address for upcoming elections.

**How to Vote from Anywhere in 2 Simple Steps... WHEN YOU'RE IN THE MILITARY**

ON BASE? STATIONED OVERSEAS? ON A SHIP? **NO MATTER WHERE YOU ARE, YOU CAN VOTE.**

If you're active duty and living away from your voting residence, you can have your absentee ballot sent to you.

**HERE'S HOW:**

**STEP 1** **FILL OUT THE FEDERAL POST CARD APPLICATION (FPCA) AT FVAP.GOV TO REGISTER AND REQUEST YOUR BALLOT**

**WHEN?** Send in your FPCA by your State's specific deadline. Find it at FVAP.gov.

**STEP 2** **FILL OUT AND SEND IN YOUR BALLOT WHEN IT ARRIVES**

**WHEN?** By your recommended deadline:

- November 1, 2016 (statewide)
- October 15, 2016 (outside the U.S.)
- October 10, 2016 (on a ship at sea)

**DIDN'T GET YOUR BALLOT IN TIME?** No worries. Get a Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB) from FVAP.gov.

**WANT TO MAKE SURE YOUR BALLOT WAS RECEIVED?** Check the status at FVAP.gov.
